



City of Narni

Starting from **24th, April 2018** visitors and tourists in Narni will be charged with a daily tourist tax - per person and overnight - applied by the different accommodation facilities in the town and its territory.

The daily tax is applied for every overnight in Narni, up to **a maximum of 4 overnights in the same facility**.

Here are the rates for 2020:

Exemptions and reductions are available for some guests:

Exemptions:

- a) minors under 14 yrs
- b) Persons with caregivers, up to 2 persons.
- c) Caregivers working for patients of the local hospital -day hospital included- up to 2 persons

- d) Patients of the local hospital, who are treated in day hospital, as well as patients who keep on being cured in town after the hospitalization, with their caregivers (up to 2 caregivers per patient).
- e) students of the local University
- f) students of the local schools
- g) Bus drivers and tourist guides - 1 guide for 20 tourist of each group.
- h) Guests of facilities living in the town after a sentence of compulsory domicile; volunteers and public officers who come into the town in order to help people after a disaster.

Exemptions are granted by the owners after receiving specific documents or self-certification.

50% Reductions:

- a) Guests of tourist groups - at least 20 persons. A tourist group is any group of tourists and visitors organized by a travel agency, staying in the same hotel or facility.
- b) Any visitor to the town who works for a company having an agreement with the municipality.
- c) Athletes, staff and players taking part in sports events in the territory.
